Admission to the Specialty: 073 Management

MASTER'S DEGREE - ADMISSION 2024 based on Bachelor's, Specialist's, Master's degree FULL-TIME AND CORRESPONDENCE STUDY

- New terminology for the admission campaign:
- Unified Professional Entrance Exam (from now on referred to as the "UPEE") is a form of entrance examination for admission to a master's degree program based on the NQF6 (bachelor's) or NQF7 (master's), which provides for the assessment of the level of preparedness of an applicant for a master's degree in the relevant specialty, conducted by the Ukrainian Center for Educational Quality Assessment.
- Unified Entrance Exam (from now on referred to as the "UEE") is a form of entrance examination for admission to a master's degree program based on the NQF6 ("Bachelor's") or NQF7 (" "Master's"), which combines a test of general academic competence and a test in a foreign language (English, German, French, Spanish at the applicant's choice), conducted by the Ukrainian Center for Educational Quality Assessment

Bachelor's Degree Program Admission Stages: Applying to the UEE, UPEE:

- Main registration period from 07 May to 29 May;
- Supplementary period from June 17 to June 21.

UEE, UPEE Tests:

- Main period from June 24 to July 15;
- Supplementary period from July 31 to August 14.

Electronic Account Registration: from July 1 to October 31.

Applicants' Interviews (instead of the UEE, for persons who will be exclusively in the competitive selection under the contract): from July 17 to July 28.

Applications Deadlines: from August 1 to August 22.

Applicants' Rating Lists Publication:

- for the Budget Form of Study by 24 August at the latest
- for the Contract Form of Study not later than September 23.

Willingness to Study Confirmation:

- for the Budget Form of Study not later than August 26;
- for the Contract Form of Study not later than September 27.

Enrollment:

• for the budget - August 27; for a contract - not later than September 30.

Transfer to Vacant budget places - August 31 at the latest

Competition Score Formula:

Competition Score (CS) $* = 0.2 \times PI + 0.2 \times P2 + 0.6 \times P3$, where:

P1 is the score of the UEE general knowledge test;

P2 - UEE foreign language test score;

P3 - score of the UEE.

(*Foreign language interview's scrore, instead of both components of the UEE, is taken into account in the competitive score with a coefficient of 0.4)
